University Faculty Senate Meeting Minutes December 6, 2013

1. The UFS meeting was called to order by Dr. Ron Nyhan, President, at 2:00 p.m. in the College of Nursing 202 on the Boca Raton Campus and video conferenced to Davie, Sea Tech, Fort Lauderdale, Harbor Branch and Jupiter.

The Senate observed a moment of silence for the late Dr. John Valentine, who was a faculty in the College of Business.

2. Without changes, the Senate approved the minutes of the November 1, 2013 Senate meeting.

3. President's Report

- The Admission and Retention Committee together with Dr. Peluso on Student Success are making great progress
- The eLearning Committee will be soon formed and will coordinate its efforts in conjunction with Dr. Vicky Brown's CEL committee.
- The State College's relationships effort will be led by Dr. Deborah Floyd and the Provost Office. Suggestions and information should be directed to Dr. Floyd for consideration.
- The schedule on the search committee for the presidential selection has been posted on Blackboard
- The resumes of the candidates will be posted on Blackboard as they become available for all FAU faculty so that they will be able to be actively engaged in the selection process.

4. UPC Consent Agenda:

- No objections from the Senate. Approved by majority vote.

5. UPC Action Item

College of Business

a) Requirement Removal – Removal of ENC 3213 as a requirement for the General Business major and Business core - No objections from Senate. Approved by majority vote.

College of Engineering & Compt. Science

a) <u>Civil Program Changes/Geomatic Program Changes</u> – No objections from Senate. **Approved by majority vote.**

6. UGC Consent Agenda:

- No objections from Senate – approved by majority vote

7. UGC Action Items:

a) College for Design and Social Inquiry

<u>Program Change</u>-Master of Public Administration – no objections from Senate-**approved by majority vote.**

b) College of Business

<u>Program Change</u> – Master of Accounting, Master of Taxation, Exec. Master of Accounting, Exec. Master of Taxation - no objections from Senate-**approved by majority vote.**

c) College of Science

<u>Program Change</u>-Professional Master of Science in Medical Physics (MSMP) - no objections from Senate-approved by majority vote.

<u>Program Change</u>- Graduate Remote Sensing Cert. - no objections from Senateapproved by majority vote.

8. Business Items:

- a) Dr. Nyhan proposed to reschedule the next Senate meeting for January 24, 2014 as the Senate's scheduled meeting for Jan 17th conflicted with the timing of the final selection of the President of FAU. The Senate unanimously approved rescheduling the meeting.
- b) Online Spots: Steering was in favor of moving forward to Senate with positive recommendation to implement the online spot evaluations in the spring 2014 semester. The Office of the Provost will coordinate the efforts to inform and encourage students to participate.

After much discussion, the Senate approved unanimously to moving forward in the implementation of online spots in the spring 2014 semester.

9. Open Forum with the Provost:

- Dr. Perry mentioned Dr. Peluso was attending the SACS Reaffirmation meeting and was hopeful that FAU would receive positive affirmation
- Dr. Perry spoke about the ten Performance metrics that FAU will need to work on in the future.
- The first eight metrics are common to all universities
- The ninth metric was chosen by the BOG i.e., number of degrees awarded without excess hours was chosen to try to differentiate FAU from other universities.
- The tenth metric was chosen by the BOT i.e., Bachelor's degrees awarded to minorities.
- The Provost Office researched this and Dr. Perry made this recommendation to the BOT at their last meeting
- Two benchmarks are tied to the metrics excellence and improvement.
- Provost Office is working on collecting data to determine which benchmark to use with the approval of the BOG and BOT

- All ten metrics have some aspects that is associated with student success
- Dr. Perry is looking to the Senate's effort to bring all the colleges together to develop a strategy to improve on student success.
- Dr. Perry encouraged the faculty to also get involved in the decision making with the upcoming Presidential Search.

12. Good of the Senate:

- The subject of P&T committee's requirement for five letters of recommendation instead of three was brought up once more
- Dr. Nyhan attended the first meeting of the newly constituted P&T committee, where he requested the committee to consider the concerns of the faculty. The committee is working in this issue and will report back to the Senate their recommendations for approval by the Senate, before being reported to the Provost Office.
- Eric Shaw is also setting up a memorial fund for John Valentine.
