- Instead, faculty should tackle the issue of student learning provide resources, supplemental lessons and develop peer tutoring programs to help struggling students who are failing in their classes.
- Deans were sent information to share with their faculty, ideas on how to lower the DFW rates with high risk courses.
- Look at the success rate of other peer mentoring programs to gage the benefit to students.
