



## FAU Students' Perspectives on Textbook Affordability



The Student Public Interest Research Group calculated that over the past twenty years textbook costs have increased at a rate four times higher than inflation.

Soaring prices are a consequence of two key factors:

- Lack of competition: Five publishers control 80 percent of the market
- No consumer choice in this purchase: Students must buy assigned materials
