**Academic Service Learning Designation Process for Existing Courses**

**Background:** In support of its application for Carnegie Community Engagement (CE) Classification, the University will identify all existing courses that meet the general requirements for Academic Service Learning (ASL) designation. The President's Community Engagement Taskforce has formed a committee of College Community Engagement Liaisons (CCEL) to identify eligible courses within each college. Once the eligible courses have been identified, the UFS will need to approve adding the ASL designation to them.

**Motion:** To streamline the process of adding ASL designation to existing courses that have previously been approved by the UFS without ASL designation, the CCEL committee shall recommend a list of such courses directly to the UFS for its consideration. This streamlined process shall apply only through the Spring 2018 semester.
