As per the current policy on Emeritus Faculty, "the title of Emeritus Professor is an honorary title which may be conferred to retired faculty or academic administrators who have a long-term history of meritorious service to higher education and Florida Atlantic University."

The faculty of the Department of Theatre and Dance would like to nominate, Jean-Louis Baldet, for the title of Professor Emeritus. Jean-Louis recently is retiring from FAU this spring where he held a faculty appointment at the rank of Professor, with tenure, and continued to exceed the University's standards of performance in all areas expected at this rank over his career.

Some of the distinguished works from Jean Baldet include:

- A prodigious record of over 40 years of service to the university, when Professor Baldet started in 1979 as an Assistant Professor, retiring as a full Professor.
- Served as Chair for the Department for 13 years on three separate occasions.
- Founding artistic director for FAU Summer Festival Repertory Theatre, a pre-professional training
 program that every student in Theatre and Dance must participate in. This program allows students to
 work with professionals in the field every summer for the past 33 years, producing over 75 productions
 in the program.
- A Distinguished record of service for the department, college, and university serving on numerous committees at all levels.
- Tireless mentoring and helping junior faculty develop into valued colleagues and instructors.
- Developed numerous grants and donations to the department and college to build our programs.
- Directed over 120 productions professionally, 71 of those productions at FAU in the department's academic program.
- Serving as a student mentor and advisor to thousands of students who have passed through the department over the years.
- Served as the head of the Acting program for FAU for over 20 years, helping to build the strong BFA and MFA programs that have led FAU Theatre and Dance to be an emerging school to attend in the nation.

His record of distinguished service to Florida Atlantic University and to his academic and creative field, with significant contributions in the area of teaching, research and service, have been consistent throughout his career. During his extensive tenure, Professor Jean-Louis Baldet has made exceptional contributions to the University through his creative activities and leadership.

We strongly recommend that Professor Baldet be awarded the title of Professor Emeritus as his work over these 40 years is reflective of his enduring commitment to the excellence of the Theatre and Dance program at Florida Atlantic University.
