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Budget Types

- Education and General (E&G) these funds include State appropriated General Revenue, Educational Enhancement (Lottery) funding, and Student Tuition. Any unused funds rollover into Carryforward the next fiscal year.
- **Auxiliaries** are funds used to provide quality services at rates competitive with private sector. Revenue may be expended for any goods and services necessary to fulfill the mission and programmatic needs of the auxiliary including salaries and operating expenditures. Examples: Self-Supporting/Market Rate Programs, Certificates, Camps; etc
- Concession Funds Contains all the commission-based revenues from beverage and pouring, snack vending, student housing laundry machines. Supports otherwise restricted purchases, such as food/alcohol at events or meals for job candidates.

Budget Types, continued

- **FAU Foundation, Inc. -** 501(c)(3) non-profit organization. Budget is created/earned by the Foundation in partnership with academic units through gifts by individuals, foundations, and corporations.
- The Contracts and Grants (C&G) budget consists of funding from federal agencies, state agencies, foundations, and private sources that enables the university to conduct specific research projects or to provide specific non-research services.
- HEERF *NEW* these funds were generated from funds that were drawn down from the Federal Grants for University lost revenues as a result of COVID. This fund type functions like an Auxiliary Fund.

Focusing on Opportunities

- \$1.4M HEERF funding for future commitments
- \$1.7M Faculty Start- Up Funds
- \$1.5M New Auxiliary/Self-Sustaining Funding
- Revenue Share MOU
- Voluntary Retirement Incentive Program
 - 40 Faculty participated in the voluntary retirement initiative process with 41 new hires approved.
 - \$900K reallocated to the colleges for the following: salary realignment of college IT Directors, support for an advisor position, ongoing support of Undergraduate Studies initiatives funded with one-time funds since 2019, and other student support initiatives including the Math Lab in College of Science.
