- 1. The UFS meeting was called to order by Dr. Kim Dunn at 1:00PM. The meeting was held in Engineering East Room 106.

Presidential Search Update

- **New President**: Mr. Adam Hasner was unanimously selected by the Board of Trustees as the next president of Florida Atlantic University and has been confirmed by the Florida Board of Governors. His term begins on March 10, 2025.
- Dr. Dunn's Suggestions During Deliberations:
 - o Retain Dr. Stacy Volnick in a key administrative role.
 - o Initiate a national search for a new provost, with Dr. Ivy continuing in the role until the search concludes.
 - Implement initiatives to create a campus environment where all students feel safe and welcome.
