Please explain the requested change(s) and offer rationale below or on an attachment <p>The current language in the catalog is contradictory, requiring 40 credits total, allowing 9 credits of lower division and requiring 37 credits of upper division. This correction will allow our transfer students to use the allowed 9 credits of lower division courses without having to take an additional upper division course. This will aid students in completing the degree on time.</p> <p>The department would like the catalog to state: In addition to the University and College requirements, all students are required to complete at least 40 credits in college-level psychology coursework and a minimum of 31 credits of the 40 credits must be upper-division (3000/4000 level). A minimum of 28 of the upper-division credits must be taken at Florida Atlantic University. Up to 12 hours of transfer psychology coursework may be applied to the psychology major, upon approval of the department. Please note that no more than 9 hours of the transfer coursework applied to the major can be at the lower-division level.</p>
