This memo represents the proposed change to the course title for the course NUR4936 Honors Seminar III in Nursing within the Undergraduate Program of the College of Nursing. The title change includes the designation of RI as follows: RI: Honors Seminar III in Nursing. The use of RI specifies the course as research intensive.

Background:

This course was originally designed with all elements to qualify for RI designation through the Office of Undergraduate Research and Inquiry. No changes to course description or objectives have been made to this current course syllabus. For an RI designation, the NUR 4936 course was aligned with the Office of Undergraduate Research and Inquiry (OURI) Student Learning Outcomes (see Syllabus p. 2). The intent of RI course designation is to specify FAU undergraduate courses deemed Research and Inquiry intensive at the undergraduate level as appropriate for each college.

The course was approved by the following College of Nursing bodies: Undergraduate Program Committee, the Committee on Programs, and the Faculty Assembly.
