Degrees, minors and certificates are now called "cybersecurity" nationwide. The government education priorities are set in terms of "cybersecurity". As such, the previous dominant term "Information Security" has taken a back seat to the point that students and stakeholders do not recognize it as equivalent to cybersecurity. Furthermore, "Cybersecurity" is more encompassing than "Information security" since it also addresses vulnerabilities and resources that are not purely informational, for example, cyberattack on the subway system, or on a nuclear plant. 2) The current change has contributions from three departments across three colleges, making this program multidisciplinary, serving more students and stakeholders.
