Please explain the requested change(s) and offer rationale below or on an attachment As a department we unanimously voted (16-0) to eliminate the requirement of "one course" in International Economics for Business Economics majors and replaced it with an "additional" economics elective. This will allow students to select from a wider variety of elective courses. In addition, the department unanimously voted (16-0) to eliminate 'Managerial Economics' from the Business Economics Course Requirements and include the course as an elective. This way all Business Economics majors take the same four core classes as General Economics: ECO 3101, ECO 3203, ECO 4421, ECO 4933. Eliminates the choice of avoiding ECO 3101.
