Please explain the requested change(s) and offer rationale below or on an attachment <p>Currently, students must earn a "C" or higher in all CCJ core and elective courses. We would like to amend this policy and the following statements appearing in the course catalog:</p> <p>A grade of "C" or higher is required for all courses being used toward the minor.</p> <p>This statement shall be amended to read:</p> <p>The core course must be completed with a grade of "C" or better. Elective courses in the minor may be completed with a grade of "C-" or better. Students must maintain a "C" average in all CCJ minor courses.</p> <p>Rationale: The current policy is inconsistent with the major. Additionally, this program change gives students greater flexibility, while maintaining academic rigor. Accordingly, this change comports with performance metrics that seek to graduate students without exceeding 120 credits. This policy change is also consistent with other programs in the University (e.g., English, Biological Sciences, and General Studies). Finally, this policy change surpassed the majority vote necessary among faculty for curriculum change in the SCCJ.</p>
