CATALOG CHANGE: FINANCE MAJOR

EXPLANATION

External reviewers suggested that we increase the flexibility of the finance program. Following their suggestion, we propose to reduce the required finance core courses from five to four, and expand the choices of electives correspondingly. The electives are to be selected to align with various career paths of interest, for example, in investment management, business finance, investment banking, commercial banking, Fintech, real estate, or risk management & insurance.

Specifically, we move "FIN4604 International Finance" from the required finance core courses to finance electives, and we also add four other courses to the list of finance electives.
