So rather than requiring students to take Ancient Greek Philosophy, Modern Philosophy I, Introduction to Logic, Ethical Theory, and Theory of knowledge, students take 15 credit hours from the philosophy course list, with at least 9 hours being at the 3,000-4,000 level.</p> <p>In addition, we specified that 9 hours of the 15 in another discipline must be at the 3,000-4,000 level.</p>
