Description/Information

The minor is available to undergraduate degree-seeking students not majoring in music and may be earned upon successful completion of the coursework below and the simultaneous completion of a bachelor's degree at FAU.

The minor requires 15 credits, with minimum grades of "C" required in all courses for the minor. For the minor, at least 12 of the 15 credits must be earned from FAU.

Timely Graduation: Minors should be considered an optional direction for elective credits. Students may not add a minor or certificate without permission from an Arts & Letters advisor (and main college advisor if different). Students are generally not permitted to add a minor/cert after earning 90 credit hours or if completing it will result in an Excess Hour Surcharge.
