~~A dismissed student, after~~ After a minimum of one year away from the University, **a dismissed student** may seek re-entry by reapplying to the University and petitioning for approval from the student's last college/major. If a student is seeking admission to a college different from the original college, the petition process will include notifying the new college regarding the student's intent. ~~If at any time after having once been dismissed, an undergraduate student has a term and cumulative average below 2.0, the student will be dismissed from the University permanently.~~ If, having been previously dismissed and reinstated through the petition process, a student is subsequently dismissed a second time, then the student may not petition for a second reinstatement and is dismissed permanently from the University.
