## **Baccalaureate Degrees of Distinction**

FAU recognizes superior academic performance by granting baccalaureate degrees of distinction to undergraduates who are recommended for that distinction by the faculty granting that degree and have earned at least 45 30 credits of graded coursework\* at FAU as follows:

- cum laude for an FAU average Institutional GPA\*\* of 3.500 or higher;
- magna cum laude for an FAU average Institutional GPA\*\* of 3.700 or higher;
- **summa cum laude** for an FAU average Institutional GPA\*\* of 3.900.

An undergraduate transfer student may qualify for a degree of distinction based on all work taken at the upper division (other institutions and FAU), a minimum of 45 credits, if the student has not completed 45 credits at FAU.

An undergraduate earning a second baccalaureate may qualify for a degree of distinction based on all work completed at FAU, a minimum of 30 credits.

\*Graded coursework of "AU," "I," "NC," "NR," "P," "S," "U," "W," and "WM" are not used in determining eligibility.

\*\*The FAU Recalculated GPA will be used, if applicable.

The GPA is truncated to three decimal points and is not rounded up.

For purposes of honors recognition at the Commencement ceremony, students must have a 3.500 GPA before the term in which they plan to graduate to have honors recognized publicly at the Commencement ceremony.

All undergraduates receiving degrees of distinction must be recommended for that distinction by the faculty granting that degree.
