## Undergraduate Student Returning After Dismissal

(Changes effective ~~spring 2025~~ fall 2025.) A dismissed student, after a minimum of one year away from the University, may seek re-entry by reapplying to the University and petitioning for approval from the student's last college/major. If a student is seeking admission to a college different from the original college, the petition process will include notifying the new college regarding the student's intent. ~~If at any time after having once been dismissed (and subsequently reinstated), the student cannot petition~~ A student who has previously been dismissed, reinstated, and then dismissed for a second time may not seek reinstatement again unless they have earned a Bachelor's degree (or higher) from another accredited institution and will remain dismissed from the University permanently.
