

Events Event Management

Undergraduate Certificate

(Minimum of 15 credits required)

The undergraduate certificate in **Events Event Management** provides an operations-focused curriculum to those who desire employment within the meetings, events, exhibitions or conventions industries. Students must complete 15 credits from the courses below. The certificate in **Events Event Management** is open to both degree-seeking and non-degree-seeking students and is available in person or fully online. All courses must be completed with a minimum grade of "C" or higher. Courses may have prerequisites, corequisites or other requirements. Non-degree-seeking students need program director approval prior to enrollment in all courses.

The certificate is particularly valuable for FAU degree-seeking students outside of the College of Business and to community members, hospitality and tourism industry professionals and seasonal residents.
