### Undergraduate Minor

To complete a minor in Arabic Studies, students are required to pass (with a grade of “C” or better) two beginning-level language courses (ARA 1120 and ARA 1121), ~~two intermediate-level language courses (ARA 2220 and ARA 2221) and one upper-division (3/4000-level) course;~~ and three additional upper-division courses, chosen in consultation with the LLCL Director of Undergraduate Studies, advisor, on a topic relating to the languages, cultures, literatures, history and/or politics of the Arab World.
