Undergraduate Minor for ~~Non-Heritage/Non-Native~~ Second-Language Learners

To complete a minor in Spanish for ~~non-heritage second-language~~ learners, students are required to pass (with a grade of “C” or better) five ~~in-lingua (SPN and SPW) prefixed~~ with prefix SPN or SPW at the intermediate level (2000-level) or higher (3000 or 4000 level) (15-17 credits). SPT 4800 Spanish Translation may replace one of these courses. These five courses should be chosen in consultation with an LLCL faculty advisor. A placement exam will determine in which course a student begins the minor. Once a student successfully completes an upper-division language course (3000 or 4000 level) (prefix SPN), it is not possible to enroll in a lower-division language course (1000 or 2000 level) (prefix SPN).

A second-language learner of Spanish is someone who grew up in a household or linguistic community where Spanish was not the primary language or one of the primary languages.

A maximum of two courses can be at the intermediate level ~~(SPN 2220 and SPN 2221) (2000 level)~~. At least 75% of the credits must be earned at FAU. Students with advanced knowledge of Spanish (beyond the intermediate level) ~~will~~ should not take any intermediate-level courses, and ~~must~~ should meet with an LLCL faculty advisor to determine which five upper-division courses to include in the minor.

~~Students must take at least one course in each of the following categories: (1) at least one advanced-level language course (SPN 3400); (2) at least one in-lingua upper-division culture and civilization course (SPN 3500 or SPN 3501); and (3) at least one in-lingua upper-division literature and civilization course (SPW 3030 is strongly recommended; other possibilities include SPW 3012, SPW 3021 or SPW 4930).~~

Students who plan to study abroad are strongly encouraged to have all courses approved by ~~the~~ an LLCL faculty advisor before beginning the program.
