Hi Ann,

I am writing to ask for your support in PJHR making a few changes to our minor/certificate program. We are adapting the program to require only one core course rather than two from a larger list. Some of these courses are not offered frequently enough (or at all) for our students to be able to complete the minor/certificate. So, rather than listing these courses as a core courses, we are moving them to the elective list, but also increasing the elective courses required for the minor/certificate from two to three or 6 to 9 credit hours. Please let me know if you have any questions or concerns. We are hoping this flexibility will increase the number of students we have in the program. We currently only have 10 enrolled.

The course impacted are:
HIS 3204: History of Human Rights
SPC 4633: Rhetoric of Social Protest
ANT 4409: Anthropology of Peace and Violence
SYA 4930: Special Topics (Human Rights)

Change the minor/certificate requirements to reflect the following:
Student takes PAX 3001 any other three courses from the approved list of core courses and electives.
Students may petition to allow up to one course that is not listed with director approval.
