<p>Please explain the requested change(s) and offer rationale below or on an attachment.</p> <p>The attached proposed revisions would replace the current description of the Minor Concentration in French. The most significant change is the elimination of references to specific required French courses. In their place, the revised description states that the minor is satisfied by the completion of five courses at the intermediate level or above with the prefixes FRE, FRW, or FRT. I have included tables indicating which courses may be counted toward the minor.</p> <p>The rationale for these revisions is included in the attached document.</p>

New degree requirements for the minor:

MINOR CONCENTRATION IN FRENCH AND FRANCOPHONE STUDIES

Students at the Wilkes Honors College who wish to add a Minor Concentration in French to their major concentration may do so by completing 15–17 credits in French. This requirement is fulfilled through five courses at the intermediate level or above with the prefix FRE/FRW/FRT, listed below.

The Minor Concentration in French and Francophone Studies is an official academic credential that appears on the student's Wilkes Honors College transcript upon graduation. Completion of the minor demonstrates academic competency in French as well as sustained engagement with Francophone cultures.

Students who enter the Wilkes Honors College with no prior experience in French may declare the minor after completing Honors FRE 1120 Beginning French Language and Culture 1 and Honors FRE 1121 Beginning French Language and Culture 2, the two-course sequence that fulfills FAU's foreign language requirement. Students who place at the intermediate level may begin the minor directly. Students who place at the advanced level, as well as native speakers of French, may begin the minor at the 3000 level. Students with prior experience in French must take the French Placement Test to confirm placement at the appropriate level (<https://www.fau.edu/artsandletters/llcl/french/fre/> , please email a screenshot of your score to Prof. Tille-Victorica).

A. Proposed Changes: Updated Program Description

B. Rationale for Changes:

1. Greater flexibility is essential to attracting more students to complete the minor concentration. These revisions bring the program into closer alignment with the more flexible requirements of the Department of Languages, Linguistics, and Comparative Literature (LLCL).
2. Under the current structure, students who begin French study at the advanced 3000 level are not able to receive a substitution for Honors FRE 2221. The new proposed version offers that flexibility.
3. Under the current structure, students who study abroad and wish to take the equivalents of Honors FRE 2220, FRE 2221, FRE 3400, or FRW 3112 are unable to substitute Honors FRE 2957, FRE 3957, and FRW 4957 for those courses while also receiving study abroad credit toward

their graduation requirements. At present, DARS recognizes study abroad credit only for FRE 2957, FRE 3957, and FRW 4957. The new proposal will fix this issue.

4. Prof. Tille-Victorica cannot offer Honors FRE 2220/2221 and upper-level courses every year. Students should therefore be permitted to take those courses through LLCL when they are not available through the Honors College. Because sustained and continuous study is essential for success in a foreign language, requiring students to wait more than a year for a course to be offered is not pedagogically sound and may hinder their progress toward fluency.

French language learners who test out of FRE2220 by taking the French placement test will need to substitute FRE2220 with another elective course of either 3 or 4 credits after successfully completing FRE2221. These students might complete the Minor Concentration in French and Francophone Studies with 17 credits instead of 18.
