RI: Health Practicum, HSA 4817

Successful completion of RI: Health Practicum is necessary for graduation. Students taking the Practicum must:

1. Have successfully completed, i.e., earned a "C" or better, the six core courses;
2. Have a GPA of 2.5 or better in all courses taken at FAU;
3. Have completed at least 33 upper-division (3000-level or above) credits;
4. Be a Health Administration program major; and
5. Not be on academic probation.

Students can take HSA4915 (Directed Independent Research in Health Administration) as an alternative to HSA4817 (Health Practicum) in the curriculum. Students who are not able to find remote practicum opportunity can take HSA4915 for 6 credits and work with the faculty on a given project. The final decision to choose between HSA 4817 and HSA 4915 is based on the approval of the internship coordinator.
