Re: Change of degree requirements for the Bachelor of Music Performance Concentration:

Vocal Option.

Date: January 30, 2015

The Department of Music proposes new courses, course changes and course content revision applicable to the Bachelor of Music Performance Concentration: Vocal Option. The changes are intended to align the degree requirements with others in the SUS and peer institutions, which include more content in diction for vocalists. This will better prepare our students for advanced studies in vocal performance and for professional performance engagements.

The new course proposed is as follows:

MUS 3222 Diction for Singers III: French (1 cr)

Course changes are as follows:

- MUS 2101 Diction for Singers 1—change title to Diction for Singers I: An Introduction
- MUS 3232 Diction for Singers II—change title to Diction for Singers II: German; change level to 3000
- MUL 4643 Survey of Choral Music Literature—change credits from 3 to 2

Courses to be removed from the degree content:

- MUO 4006 Musical Theater Workshop I
- MUO 4008 Musical Theatre Workshop II
- MVV 2171 Introduction to Stage Presence for the Vocal Artist
- MUE 2430 Voice Techniques—MVV 2601 Introduction to Vocal Pedagogy replaces this course

The changes do not change the degree total of 120, however, it will change the number of electives required from 12 to 14, which may include music courses.
