SUBJECT: Establishment of an upper division FAU Max Planck Honors Program

Under the auspices of the Jupiter Life Science Initiative, the Schmidt College of Science and the Wilkes Honors College, working in partnership with the Max Planck Institute for Neuroscience (MPFIN), propose a Jupiter-specific honors program, to be titled the FAU Max Planck Honors Program (MPHP). The FAU MPHP will provide honors students, selected from those who apply from the College of Science and the Wilkes Honors College, with a singular experience consisting of exclusive enrichment opportunities, including courses taught/co-taught with Max Planck scientists. At present, the MPFIN is the only Max Planck Institute in North America and joint MPFI programs exist only at the graduate level. Undergraduate student participants in the proposed program who maintain all standards and fulfill all requirements of the MPHP, described herein, will receive a designation of “FAU Max Planck Honors” on their final transcript.

Attached please find the new honors program proposal, the proposed changes to the relevant catalog entries (changes tracked in red), a series of new, program-specific course proposals, and confirmations of no conflict.
