The faculty members and director of the hospitality management program within the FAU College of Business propose the following two items for change.

ITEM #1

The hospitality management program's director and faculty members would like to **ADD** HFT 4253, Hotel & Resort Management to the listing of major/core required courses.

Currently, the list of required major/core courses is as follows:

Introduction to Hospitality Management HFT 3003 (Pre: 30 credits) Principles of Hospitality Law HFT 3603 (Pre: HFT 3003 & BUL 4421)

Hospitality Marketing and Revenue Mgmt. Practices HFT 4503 (Pre: HFT 3003)

Excellence in Guest Service Management HFT 4240 (Pre: HFT 3003)

Performance Analysis for Hospitality Managers HFT 4453 (Pre: HFT 3003, 90 credits, majors only) Field Experience in Hospitality Management HFT 4941 (Pre: HFT 3003 & dept. permission) (0 credits)

The **PROPOSED ITEM #1 CHANGE** would be to change the list of required major/core courses as follows:

Introduction to Hospitality Management HFT 3003 (Pre: 30 credits) Principles of Hospitality Law HFT 3603 (Pre: HFT 3003 & BUL 4421)

Hospitality Marketing and Revenue Mgmt. Practices HFT 4503 (Pre: HFT 3003)

Excellence in Guest Service Management HFT 4240 (Pre: HFT 3003)

Hotel & Resort Management HFT 4253 (Pre: HFT 3003) ← ADD COURSE HERE
Performance Analysis for Hospitality Managers HFT 4453 (Pre: HFT 3003, 90 credits, majors only)
Field Experience in Hospitality Management HFT 4941 (Pre: HFT 3003 & dept. permission) (0 credits)

Rationale for this Change:

- 1) The course (HFT 4253) has inherent curriculum items that instill the competencies and skills for overall hospitality management majors, regardless of future employment segment.
- 2) The hotel & resort industry segments employ over 75% of our working students and over 70% of our alumni.
- 3) The course (HFT 4253) is already included as a major/core course within peer programs of hospitality management found in the state university system (SUS) and beyond.
- 4) The addition of the course (HFT 4253) to the major/core course list has been strongly suggested by regional and local hotel & resort industry professionals as well as participants within our program's ad hoc industry advisory group.

ITEM #2

Next, since the Hotel & Resort Management course is currently in the hospitality management program's "Select From" list, it must be deleted in order to be moved as indicated in Item #1 above.

This change results in NO OVERALL CHANGES TO TOTAL CREDIT HOURS FOR THE MAJOR - just a shift in which courses are required and which are "select from".
