The Minor in Architectural Studies is intended to be available to all full-time students at Florida Atlantic University pursuing a declared major. The minor will be offered by the School of Architecture in the College for Design and Social Inquiry.

Minor in Architectural Studies

The Minor in Architectural Studies offers students the possibility to gain insight into the discipline of Architecture. The program will broaden a student's global background on the relationships between the built environments and cultural meaning. Students enrolled in the Pre-Architecture or the Bachelor of Architecture program are not eligible to enter the Minor in Architectural Studies program. However, students transferring out of the Pre-Architecture or Bachelor of Architecture programs may opt to receive recognition for their efforts spent in the major by completing requirements for the minor.

9 of the 15 required credits for the minor must be taken at the upper level. A grade of C or better is required for all courses in the minor. A minimum of 75% of all minor courses must be completed at FAU. To apply for the minor, a student must complete an application and submit it to the College for Design and Social Inquiry, SO104. The application may be submitted once the final course is in progress. Minors will be noted on the student's transcript.
