





 Re: Department of Theatre and Dance – Minor in Dance Proposal  
 Date: September 15, 2015

The Department of Theatre and Dance is proposing an 18 credit Minor in Dance that would be available to all undergraduate students across the University. A minor in dance is in high demand from students in a wide range of majors including exercise science, business, psychology, biology, molecular science, elementary education, and criminal justice - just to name a few areas of interest. Completion of dance minor requirements is an aspiration of many students who are currently enrolled and prospective students (including out-of-state students) who wish to matriculate at FAU. Each semester dance courses fill to capacity. There is one full-time faculty member and three adjunct dance faculty to meet the interest for dance courses. Students have enrolled in dance courses and participated in dance productions and want academic acknowledgement to support these endeavors. A dance minor fills a need that has been requested by students for a decade.

Auditions are scheduled once per semester and, if passed, allows the student to declare the Minor and register for classes the following semester. The Dance Minor requires a minimum of 18 credits. All courses used to fulfill the minor, must be completed with a grade of "C" or better.

**NOTE:** Transfer students seeking a Minor in Dance may apply *equivalent* lower level courses only (Level 1), toward their minor. *Equivalence* will be determined by the student's academic advisor in the Department of Theatre and Dance. At least 75 percent of all credits required for the minor must be earned at FAU. A minimum of nine credit hours must be unique to the minor and may not be used to satisfy requirements in the major.

**NOTE:** In order to enroll in an upper division elective course, students must have taken the appropriate course prerequisites or have received permission from the instructor.
