Program Description (provide a brief description of the program, including thesis or non-thesis option)	The B.A./M.A. in History combined degree program will enable outstanding students to graduate with both a Bachelor of Arts in the Liberal Arts and Sciences with a Concentration in History, and a Master of Arts in History, in as little as 5 years. The program is 150 credit hours (B.A./M.A. with thesis option) or 156 credit hours (B.A./M.A. without thesis option). Students complete 120 hours for the undergraduate degree and 30 hours (thesis option) or 36 hours (non-thesis option) for the graduate degree. Students complete the undergraduate degree first, taking no more than 12 credit hours of graduate coursework in their senior year, which can be used to satisfy requirements for both degrees. Prospective students must formally apply to this program and meet all admission requirements.
